NEFHIMA MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES

Active Membership: Any person who lives in the Northeast region and holds an AHIMA credential or is the Director /Manager/Chairperson of a department or organization engaged in health information management or medical record work may be admitted to active membership upon receipt of dues and shall be entitled to vote, to hold office and to serve on committees or projects.

Student Membership: Any Student enrolled in formal health information management or medical record education programs located in the Northeast region, including independent study programs, may hold student membership upon receipt of dues. Student members may serve on committees but shall not be entitled to vote, to hold office or to serve as delegate.

Corporate Membership: Any corporation interested in the purposes of health information management or medical record administration is eligible for corporate membership. The corporation shall designate one representative, who shall have rights and privileges of regional (only, not state or national) association membership, limited to serving on committees with voice and vote, but only on such committees.
